Licensing Act 2003
Application for a New Premises Licence

I refer to the above new premises licence applied under the Licensing Act 2003.

This application was presented before a Licensing Sub Committee on 11 May 2023

Having taken into consideration all of the information and representations made by all parties at the hearing and in writing. The Licensing Sub Committee determined the application as follows.

'The license be granted subject':

'Condition to be added that there will only be 1 small event per month.'

'Condition to be added that license to be reviewed after 3 years.'

The reasons for reaching this decision are as follows;

'The bass sounds propagate further than other noise, even at a lower sound, but is to be especially monitored.'

'Communication has been an issue, but the applicant is going to address this issue.'

'The license can be brought back for review at any time by representative authorities.'

'Substantive licensing conditions are being attached to the license.'

'No representations made about crime, disorder or protection of children'

All parties have a right of appeal to the Magistrates Court against the decision within 21 days from the date of this notification to do so. The address of the Magistrates Court is:
